Feature walls reflect the time of day, as well as the changing seasons, while volume and transition are notable motifs.

Set on a forested slope, with sensational views of Mount Yotei, the free-standing, two-storey residences will demonstrate the same calming aesthetic as the resort, with interiors customisable to suit individual preferences.
